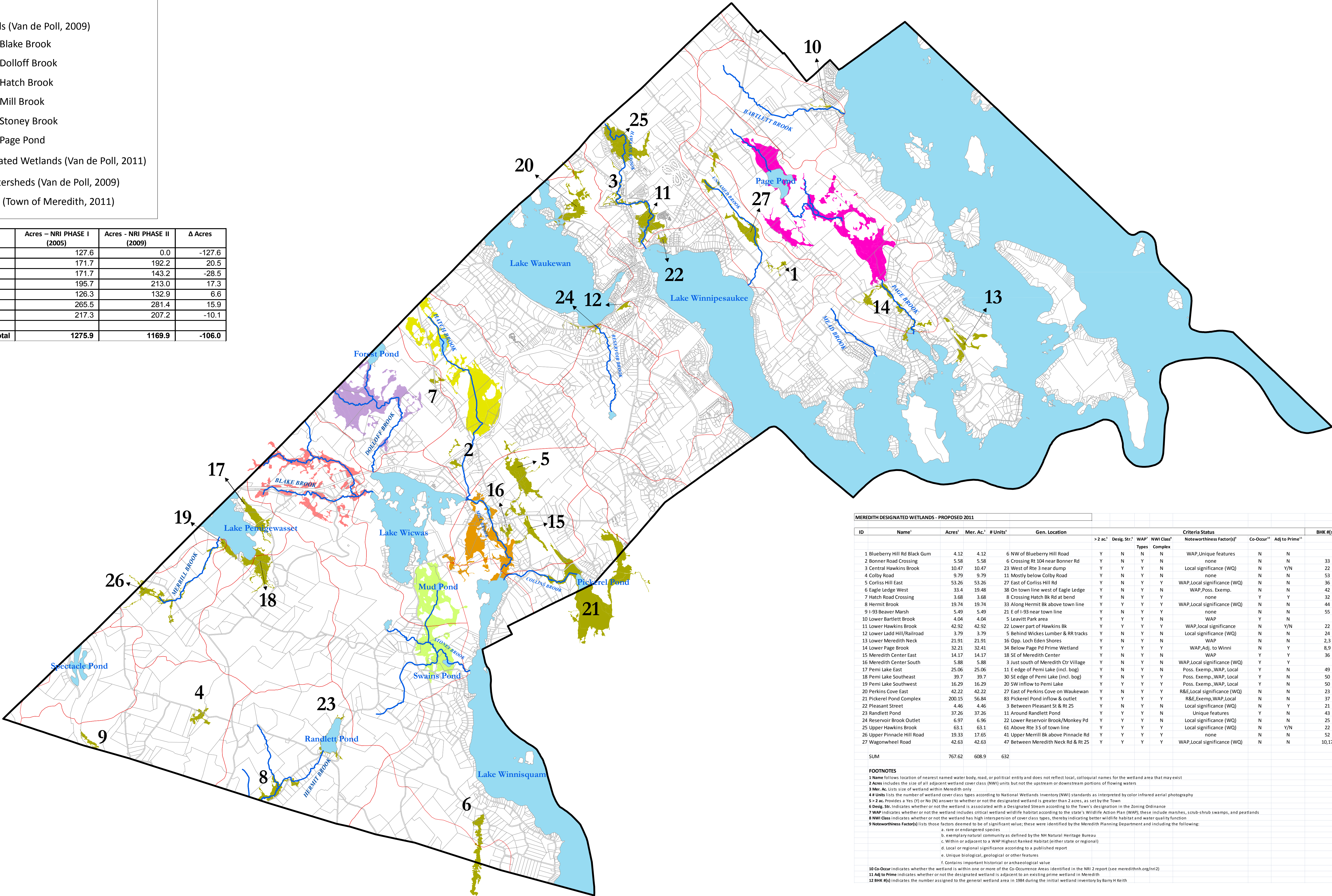

1 Name follows location of nearest named water body, road, or political entity and does not reflect local, colloquial names for the wetland area that may exist														
2 Acres includes the size of all adjacent wetland cover class (NWI) units but not the upstream or downstream portions of flowing waters														
3 Mer. Ac. Lists size of wetland within Meredith only														
4 # Units lists the number of wetland cover class types according to National Wetlands Inventory (NWI) standards as interpreted by color infrared aerial photography														
5 > 2 ac. Provides a Yes (Y) or No (N) answer to whether or not the designated wetland is greater than 2 acres, as set by the Town														
6 Desig. Str. Indicates whether or not the wetland is associated with a Designated Stream according to the Town's designation in the Zoning Ordinance														
7 WAP indicates whether or not the wetland includes critical wetland wildlife habitat according to the state's Wildlife Action Plan (WAP); these include marshes, scrub-shrub swamps, and peatlands														
8 NWI Class indicates whether or not the wetland has high interspersed cover class types, thereby indicating better wildlife habitat and water quality function														
9 Noteworthiness Factor(s) lists those factors deemed to be of significant value; these were identified by the Meredith Planning Department and including the following:														
a. rare or endangered species														
b. exemplary natural community as defined by the NH Natural Heritage Bureau														
c. Within or adjacent to a WAP Highest Ranked Habitat (either state or regional)														
d. Local or regional significance according to a published report														
e. Unique biological, geological or other features														
f. Contains important historical or archaeological value														
10 Co-Occur indicates whether the wetland is within one or more of the Co-Occurrence Areas identified in the NRI 2 report (see meredithnh.org/nri2)														
11 Adj to Prime indicates whether or not the designated wetland is adjacent to an existing prime wetland in Meredith														
12 BHK #(s) indicates the number assigned to the general wetland area in 1984 during the initial wetland inventory by Barry H Keith
