Membership Committee Report:

- Randy announced that he had received an e-mail on 1/3/12 from Dallas Wrath stating he no longer had the time to continue on the WWAC because of business demands for his time. The WWAC team wishes him well and thanks him for his past participation.
- Randy asked Tim Whiting to confirm that he wished to be reinstated as a WWAC member. Tim said he would like to be reinstated.
- Action Item: Randy Eifert Send request to Phil Warren to reinstate Tim Whiting and announce Dallas Wrath's resignation.

High Risk Septic System Health Regulation:

- There was substantial discussion on the next steps to be taken regarding this regulation. At the 12/19/11 Meredith Selectmen's workshop, it was agreed to have a Summer 2012 public charette to present/discuss the rationale behind the proposed health regulation.
- The Selectmen requested more scientific data be available regarding the causes of the Cyanobacteria algae blooms and the source of phosphorus causing them.
 - Action Item: John Edgar Request NHDES assistance to present a scientific evaluation of Lake Waukewan's water based on the VLAP and other data obtained through the years.
- Per the Selectmen's suggestion, it was recommended that all the property owners that have camps/homes on the lake front with no septic system on record be contacted to inform them of that.

Action Item: WWAC – Create a letter to be sent to these property owners.

The 12/7/11 WWAC meeting minutes were approved as had been drafted.
