ZONING AMENDMENT ARTICLE

ARTICLE 2

Are you in favor of adopting the amendment as proposed by the Planning Board for the Meredith Zoning Ordinance as follows: Amend Article VIII- Definitions to include a new definition for Island Lot and amend definitions of Lot and Lot Frontage to exempt lots on islands without a road system and which are served only by boat from the town's 50-foot road frontage requirement and to allow those lots to receive building permits under the "island exception" of the state statute that requires building permits only be issued to lots having street access.
